To amend title 23, United States Code, to require a State with an increase in the number of fatalities or serious injuries of pedestrians or users of nonmotorized forms of transportation to include strategies to address the increase in the State's subsequent State strategic highway safety plan, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Pedestrian Fatalities
3 Reduction Act of 2014”.

4 **SEC. 2. SPECIAL RULE FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY.**

5 Section 148(g) of title 23, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding at the end the following:

7 “(3) PEDESTRIANS.—

8 “(A) STATE-LEVEL INCREASE.—If the
9 number of fatalities or serious injuries of pedes-
10 trians or users of nonmotorized forms of trans-
11 portation in a State increases per capita during
12 the most recent 2-year period for which data
13 are available, the State shall be required to in-
14 clude, in the State’s subsequent State strategic
15 highway safety plan, strategies to address the
16 increase in such number.

17 “(B) COUNTY-LEVEL INCREASE.—If the
18 number of fatalities or serious injuries of pedes-
19 trians or users of nonmotorized forms of trans-
20 portation in a county of a State increases per
21 capita over the most recent 2-year period, the
22 State shall be required to include, in the State’s
23 subsequent State strategic highway safety plan,
24 strategies to address the increase in such num-
25 ber in that county.”.

1 **SEC. 3. ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATION FOR STRATEGIC**
2 **HIGHWAY SAFETY PLANS.**

3 Section 148(d)(1)(B) of title 23, United States Code,
4 is amended—

5 (1) in clause (vii) by striking “and” at the end;

6 (2) in clause (viii) by striking the period at the
7 end and inserting “; and”; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(ix) data on fatalities and injuries of
10 pedestrians and users of nonmotorized
11 forms of transportation.”.

12 **SEC. 4. MODEL INVENTORY OF ROADWAY ELEMENTS.**

13 Section 148(f)(2)(A) is amended by striking “road-
14 way safety” and inserting “roadway safety, including ele-
15 ments that improve safety for pedestrians and users of
16 nonmotorized forms of transportation”.
